PROJECT PROPOSAL

MACA ARP Funds are to be used by individual artists for proposed Projects that have been or will be conducted and completed within the grant period of May 1, 2022 - December 31, 2022.

These Projects include: providing artistic presentations, hosting workshops, or the creation of artwork with tangible outcomes (a specified community impact or raising awareness of the arts).

*** Support for a one-time award to honor or recognize an individual's achievement is not allowed. ***

***"Artist relief" including rent or food subsidies to alleviate financial hardship is not allowed. ***

*** Business expenses of individual artists are not permissible under this award. ***

- Provide a list of who you will be working with (organizations, partners, communities, audience, etc.).

ESTIMATED BUDGET

MACA ARP Funds are <u>not</u> meant to be used as relief funds, but rather as a means to assist Individual artists as they establish and re-engage in producing arts and cultural programs and activities.

- Your total Project Proposal budget should equal the amount of funding you requested above.
- No match is required.

Artist's Fees

- Your budget should reflect expenses incurred ONLY between May 1, 2022 December 31, 2022.
- Individual artists that receive funding may be allocated 60% of their total grant award upon submission of their signed Award Letter. The remaining 40% of budgeted expenses will be reimbursed upon submission of appropriate documentation, the Final Report, and within the timeline provided in the MACA ARP Fund Guidelines.

NOTE: Full funding of the allocated grant amount is contingent on the documentation provided by the Individual. If adequate expenses and documentation cannot be provided, any MACA ARP funds unaccounted for must be returned to MACA. Taxes are not reimbursable.

- Accepted expenses include costs solely associated with your proposed project(s) including: Artist's fees, Travel costs (mileage and lodging), Supplies necessary for providing workshops, Marketing and promotional fees, etc.
- Expenses that will **NOT** be reimbursed include: Costs associated with personal financial hardship; Operational business expenses including rent, utilities, etc.; Food or drink; etc.

Payments will occur via physical check and may take 3 - 6 weeks to process.

Checks will be mailed to the address you provided in this application.

Eligible Projects may receive 60% of the total allocated grant amount as an initial payment, with the remaining 40% distributed after the Final Report and supporting documentation has been approved.

NOTE: Full funding of the allocated grant amount is contingent on the documentation provided by the Individual. If adequate expenses and documentation cannot be provided, any MACA ARP funds unaccounted for must be returned to MACA.
